## LUXURY TREEHOUSE STAY

PERCHED HIGH in a third-growth redwood forest near Occidental, the Spyglass Treehouse offers guests a one-of-a-kind overnight stay. Designer and builder Will Beilharz first came to Sonoma County in 2011 to help construct a zipline course, and the experience of working and sleeping high in the redwoods stuck with him. Over a decade later, Beilharz's company, Artistree Home, which he founded with his mother, Amy Beilharz, constructs treehouses and tiny homes for customers around the world.
